1. The programme of the course is oriented to perfecting of the technique of interpretation of Italian operas of W.A. Mozart and in generally of Italian opera repertoire
2. The Masterclass will be held in the “L. Cherubini” State Conservatory in Florence from Monday 4th November to Sunday 10th November 2002.
3. The course is open for the students or graduates at Italian Institutes of music teaching and students or graduated at foreign Academies and Universities of Music (in both cases with the title of the study not former that December 31st 1999).
4. On 4th November, at 10 a.m., in the Buonumore Hall in “L. Cherubini” State Conservatory in Florence (Piazzetta delle Belle Arti n. 2), it will take place the auditions for the selection of Regular Students. The candidates that will not take part in the selection or will not be selected, can be admitted to the course as Students Auditors.
5. The candidates will have to present:
 - the application form using the relevant attached form, with an indication of two pieces at their free choice, to present during the audition and with proposals of other pieces they intend to perform during the Masterclass.
 - the certificate of paying-in the “Enrolment Fee” (not repayable) in the value of € 25 to be effected into the current account no. 5512/00 in Cassa di Risparmio di Firenze, Agenzia 28, ABI 06160, CAB 02828 made out to:

The applications without the certificate of paying-in will not be taken into consideration.

6. After the audition of the candidates (and in any case before the first lesson with Maestro Panerai) the payment of the following “Attendance Fee” will be requested:
 - Regular Students: € 250
 - Students Auditors: € 100All the participants will have to provide a valid identification.
7. The Regular Students will be allowed to take advantage of the free assistance of collaborating Teachers-pianists for all the duration of the Course.
8. All the participants can take an advantage of the services of the Vivahotels® Reservation Centre for accommodation: it is possible to have agreed rates both in the hotels of Vivahotels® Group and in other Florentine accommodation facilities. 9. The final concert of the best students of the Masterclass, with the special participation of the baritone Rolando Panerai, will be held on Saturday the 9th of November 2002 at 9 p.m. in the Buonumore Hall at the “L. Cherubini” State Conservatory in Florence.
10. At the end of the concert the best students will receive a certificate of participation signed by the Maestro Rolando Panerai.
11. The organisation intends to highlight to the public the initiative and its participants through appropriate media.
12. Furthermore the activity of the Masterclass predicts a possibility to organise visits in Florentine museums and musical institutions.
